

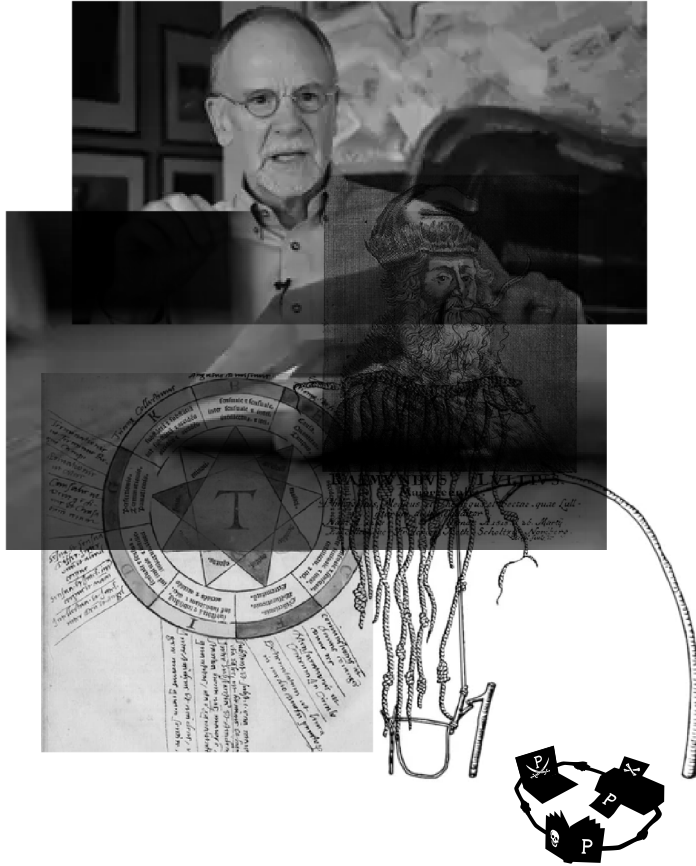

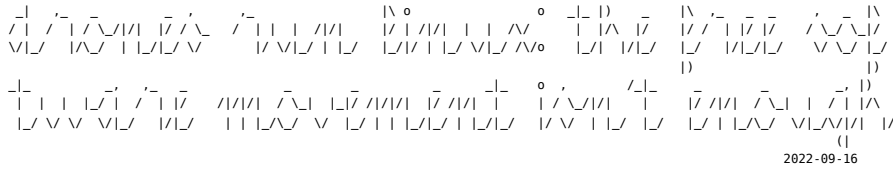

rms has led the free software movement

snapp ing

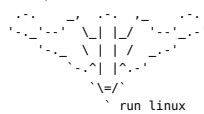
using non-free software is not a

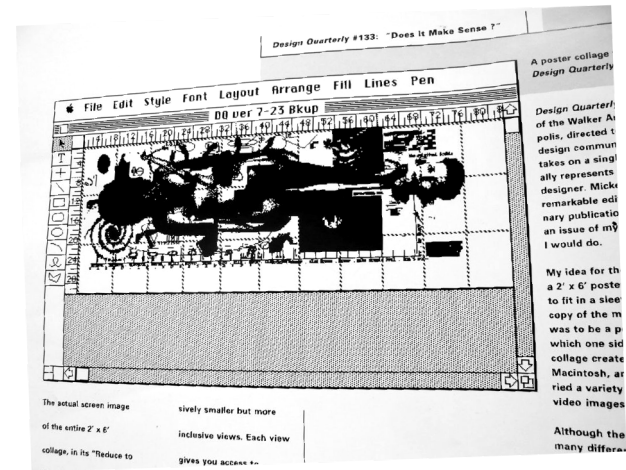

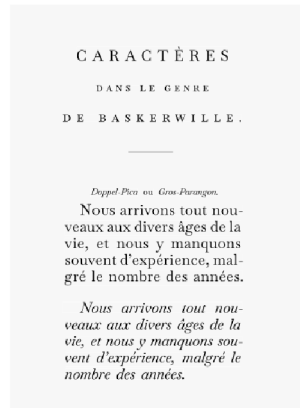
