in reality, he's a very flawed human that discovered something most of us never will. a single cause to commit the rest of his entire life to.

rms has led the free software movement for 40 years. his asset is his flaw. he is stubborn. extremely stubborn. absolutely unwilling to deviate, admit fault, change, or back down. a staunch revolutionary on a blazing battleground. the world will see free software as a moral right, and he will die fighting, no matter what anyone says.

i believe that the free software movement is over, and that it has been over for years. all that remains are a few men with grey beards, tattered war drums, and a long line of allegations. at the end of the day, the free software movement was colonized. and we tried to save it.

and god. we tried.

you might say they probably weren't real friends if they forgot about me so easily. but they were real to me. try it yourself, and see what happens.


ultimately, my stubborn resistance made no difference.
