





but stallman is an old man now. the world moved on without him. he beats the same war drum, but nobody is listening. groups of capital formed, and two libertarians started the open source movement[1] as a corporate-friendly free software alternative.

i refused to use discord for years - but instead of furthering freedom, i hurt myself. the severance of many meaningful relationships. most of my old friends simply moved on without me. if you don't have vocal chords, people forget that you exist.

you might say they probably weren't real friends if they forgot about me so easily. but they were real to me. try it yourself, and see what happens.

ultimately, my stubborn resistance made no difference.

most people don't care about the free software movement. the benefits are vague, and the consequences are life-changing. you lose touch with friends and family. it takes a lot more time and energy to navigate.

to bank. to find restaurants or activities, looking at things to buy, tracking your calendar. doing your taxes. living.

eventually, you will realize that it's not worth it. you'll start using software that eases your life, and you'll question whether all of this denial was worth it.
